With this in mind Mick George Ltd can divert the following materials from landfill;


- Soils, inert or contaminated
- Hardcore and concrete
- Paper and cardboard
- Wood including MDF and contaminated wood
- Plasterboard
- Non-ferrous and ferrous metals
- Polythene
- Plastics
- Vegetation and green waste
- Glass
- Food
- Cable wire
- UPVC Windows
- Waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE)
- Fluorescent tubes
- Carpets
- Textiles

The effect of finding alternative homes for the materials listed above has increased our landfill diversion rates across the company to approximately 85%. We will work towards performance reporting using the methods laid out in PAS 402: 2013 *Waste Resource Management – Specification*. Our objective is to achieve 100% landfill diversion for the classes of material that can be diverted and we are confident that we can achieve this goal.

Mick George Ltd is a responsible company providing sustainable solutions for the Environment and will continue strive to improve our landfill diversion rates by innovation and hard work.

This policy will be made available to our employees, those working for or on behalf of MGL and provided on request to any other interested parties. The policy will be reviewed annually, subject to changes in company procedure or legislation.
